### **School Parliament Election**

20<sup>th</sup> June 2022 marked the investiture ceremony covering all the elected representatives of the School Parliament and conferred our students with sashes.

### **Board Examination Results**

Last academic year 2021 - 22, 59 students of Class X and 23 students of Class XII appeared for Board Examination. We are proud that they came out with excellent results. 4 of our students scored 100% marks in English and Science. 15 students secured more than 90% in all subjects. 37 Students passed with distinction in Class X examination and 3 students passed with distinction in Class XII Board Examination. Toppers in Class X & Class XII Board Examination received the excellence awards from the chief guest Shri N.A. Nellikunnu, M.L.A. of Kasaragod.

### **Celebration and Day Observance**

The school takes keen interest in making children aware of the important days in the school calendar through various celebrations and day observances. Environmental day - the celebration was focused on combating single use plastic pollution. Reading day was



held on the birth anniversary of the great Malayalam Literary Scholar P.N. Panicker. International Day against Drug Abuse was on 26<sup>th</sup> June. The school made all efforts to bring on the right kind of focus and attention to the anti-drug campaign. In order to drive home, the anti drugs awareness among our children and society a large number of programmes were organized by our school. The anti drug club, Nallapadam club and Scouts and Guides unit organized a drug march and seminar to highlight the consequences of drug use. An anti drug awareness seminar for the children was led by Mr. Rajesh, S.I. of Kasaragod who gave a very informative class and cleared the doubts of the students.

After two years of gap we organized almost all the celebrations of the calendar year with all pomp and pageantry. Special occasions like Independence day, Onam, Teachers' Day, Jaimatha Day and Children's Day were celebrated in a befitting manner. Delicious Onam Sadhya was prepared for 1600 students and staff. For our school, it was indeed a memorable event. Teacher's day & children's day celebration stood out as a special occasion to bring out the special bond between the teachers and students of our school.

We have always been on the forefront of celebrating Independence Day. This year we celebrated the 75<sup>th</sup> Independence Day of our nation in all its pomp and pageantry. The flag was hoisted for three days. Shri N.A.Nellikunnu, MLA, Kasaragod was the chief guest and delivered an inspiring speech reminding students about the importance of the day. We conducted the exhibition that portrait the importance of Independence Day. As usual our band students participated in Independence day Parade at Kasaragod Muncipal stadium and our students also participated in cultural programmes like display and patriotic song.

International Yoga day was observed on the theme - Freedom for Humanity. As per CBSE instructions, International Yoga day celebration was done at district level at Bekal Fort, a historical Monument. 14 of our students participated in this event.

The Arts day celebration was held on 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2022. The well known cultural activist and magician Mr. Balachandran Kottodi inaugurated the Arts day celebration. Spirited Competitions were spread out for 2 days creating beautiful moments where hundreds of child artists taking part in number of cultural competitions. Kasaragod Sahodaya School District Arts Fest was held in two phases. First phase was hoisted in our school and Second phase was organized by Christ CMI Public School, Kanhangad. 190 students participated in this mega events. Our school emerged as the first Runner Up for the Kasaragod District Kalotsavam.

State level Arts Fest was held at Carmel CMI Public School, Vazhakulam on 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> November 2022. 8 students of our school participated and all of them secured A grade and B grade respectively.

### **Annual Sports Meet**

The school annual sports meet was held on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2022. Rev. Fr. George Vallimala, Vicar of St. Joseph Church, Kasaragod inaugurated the sports meet and received the salute. A colourful march past and elegant performance by the school band and beautiful display by the students marked the inaugural ceremony. The students took part in various sports activities in enthusiasm and sportsman ship.

Our school was 1<sup>st</sup> Runner up in Kasaragod Sahodaya School District Athletic Meet. Three of our students, Pavanth K. Shetty, C.K. Preran Prabhakar and Shahaban Akthar secured overall champions in this meet. Kasaragod Sahodaya Kho-Kho and Basketball



championship was conducted at our school. Our Kho Kho and Basketball players were out smarted the rivals with unmatched ease, accuracy and consistency. In Kho Kho under 14 and 16 boys and under 14 girls were Winners and under 16 girls were Runner up. In Basketball under 19 and 16 Boys were Winners and under 19 girls were Runner up. We are also the Champions for Football Tournament under 14, 16 & 19.

### **PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENTS OF STUDENTS**

Four of our students, Abshar Hameed T.A., Aboobacker Aziyan, C.K.Preran Prabhakar and Prasanna K. had the good fortune to participate in the 27<sup>th</sup> sub-junior National Tennis Ball Cricket Championship held at St. Bede's Sports Ground, Chennai from 15<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> August 2022. They were chosen as the best players and selected for the National South Zone Team.

On 13<sup>th</sup> November, in connection with Children's Day 8 students of our school participated in International Abacus Competition. Out of which 7 students secured Champion of Champions and one became the Champion.

Deepika Colour India District wise competition was inaugurated in our school by Monsgr. Joseph Ottaplackal, Vicar General of Thalassery Archdiocese on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022. Kumari Sumedha P.S. secured 1<sup>st</sup> prize in District Coloring Competition under higher secondary category.

In association with Deepika Children's League, Zeta Academy conducted the Quizeta Kasaragod Zone Quiz Competition held in our school on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Mithun Premraj, I.A.S, Asst. Collector of Kasaragod. Students from six schools participated in this Quiz competition and our students secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

### **BEYOND THE CURRICULUM**

All that is worth knowing cannot be taught or learned in the classroom. Our year-long co-curricular activities have opened up avenues for the holistic development of children. Training in Karate, Western Dance, Roller Skating and Chess were provided.

### **TRAINING PROGRAMMES**

Various training programmes for our students, teachers as well as for parents were organised at our school. Latest use of technology, using panel board were given to teachers by Mr. Christy Jose. Mr. Yunus Mohammed has taken classes on topics Goal settings, Personality Development, Learning Style and Career Mapping for Classes 10 & 12. An inspiring and enriching class on new gen parenting was given to the parents by a famous psychologist Dr. Lambert Kishore. Mr. Aji R., a memory trainer and Vedic Mathematics teacher having the record of 187.4 IQ conducted classes on Vedic Math & Mental Math for students of Classes 9 - 12.

### **WALKING AN EXTRA MILE**

Jaimatha is always ready to walk an extra mile for the benefit of society at large. Under the leadership of Ms. Veena Prabhakaran, Ms. Lissy Thomas and Ms. Jayasree, the Scouts and Guides Unit and Nallpadam Club students visited the Endosulfan survivors at Navajeevan school, Perla.
